Jefferson State Community College Equity in Athletics (EADA) Report

The following report has been completed using data from September 1, 2023 to August 31, 2024.

- 1. JSCC enrolled 813 male full-time undergraduates and 1220 female full-time undergraduates in the Fall semester, resulting in a total of 2,033 full-time undergraduate students. During the 2023-2024 academic year were 8,251 individual female students, 4,799 individual male students, and 3 individual students for whom gender was not reported. Racial breakdowns were as follows:
 - a. 78 American Indian or Alaska Native
 - b. 331 Asian
 - c. 3024 Black or African American
 - d. 331 Hispanic
 - e. 22 Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander
 - f. 8367 White
 - g. 876 Two or more races
 - h. 24 Not reported
- 2. \$81,612 was spent on athletically-related student aid for male athletes in competition, and \$64,121 was spent on athletically-related student aid for female athletes.
- 3. 56 percent of athletically-related student aid was awarded to male student-athletes in competition, and 44 percent of athletically-related student aid was awarded to female student-athletes.
- 4. In total, \$164,601.15 in expenses was incurred by JSCC for men's athletics in competition, \$136,442.11 for women's athletics, and \$301,043.26 for the athletic department overall. This includes athletically-related aid.

Please note that there were \$32,999.33 in general expenses not attributed to a specific program for the year.

- 5. No money was spent on recruiting for the men's or women's teams in this reporting year.
- 6. \$164,601.15 in revenue was received by JSCC for men's athletics, \$136,442.11 for women's athletics, and \$334,042.59 for the athletic department overall.
- 7. The head coach for the men's golf team earned a salary of \$16,000, and the head coach for the women's golf team earned a salary of \$12,000 during the reporting year. The head coach for the men's team was a part-time contractor. The head coach for the women's team was a part-time contractor.
- 8. The head coach for the men's cross-country team earned a salary of \$5,000.04, and the head coach for the women's cross-country team earned a salary of \$5,000.04 during the reporting year. The head coach for the men's & women's teams was a part-time contractor.
- 9. Jefferson State Community College was a member for NJCAA Division I golf and Division II cross-country during the 2023-2024 reporting year, with men's and women's teams in each sport.
 - a. 12 student athletes participated on the men's golf team; 6 student athletes participated on the women's golf team.
 - b. 5 student athletes participated on the men's cross-country team; 6 student athlete participated on the women's cross-country team. These numbers represent the unduplicated head count for all participating student athletes in this reporting year.
 - c. The head coach for the men's golf team was a male, part-time contractor. The head coach for the women's team was a female, part-time contractor.
 - d. The head coach for the men's and women's cross-country team was a male, parttime contractor.
- 10. The overall graduation rate was 22%. The transfer-out rate was 38%.
