## **Affidavit of Financial Support**

The United States Department of Homeland Security (DHS) requires that international students demonstrate that they will be financially able to support themselves during their entire period of study in the United States. Therefore, proper completion and submission of this form is required, along with proof of the required finances. F-1 students are dependent financially on their sponsors and should not plan to work on-campus or off-campus while attending Jefferson State Community College.

Supporting evidence of financial resources must be attached to this affidavit. Acceptable documents are those issued by a bank or other financial institution on bank letterhead, such as checking or savings account information. If the name on the account is a business or corporation, there must be official documents to show that the sponsor is the owner of the business or corporation. The documents must be original or certified copies of the original, be dated within six months of intended enrollment, and show a US dollar figure of at least the amount of support indicated above. Income tax statements, land holdings, salary declarations and proof of personal property, certificates of deposit, and computer printouts are not acceptable.
