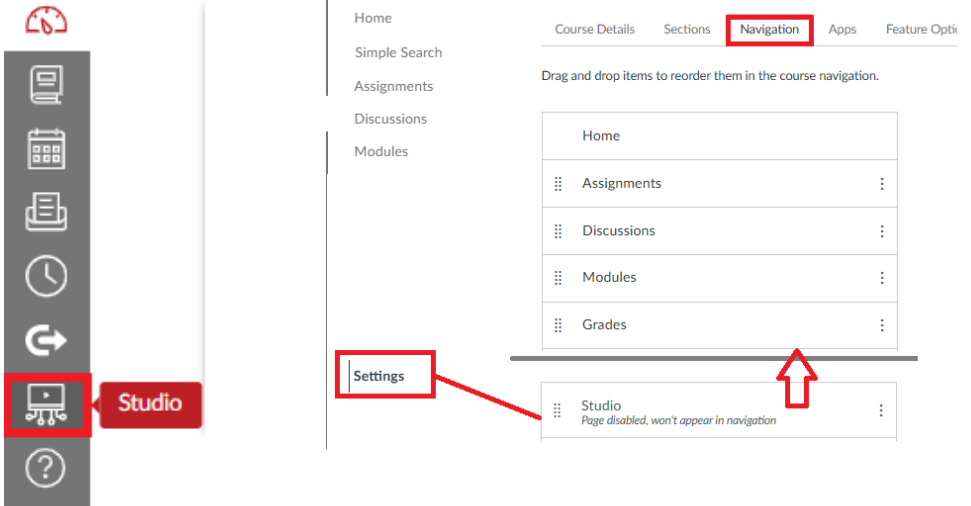


Adding Studio Videos to Canvas Handout

Access Canvas Studio through the Icon on the Global Menu. You can also access through individual courses (must enable Studio from the Navigation settings – drag/move Studio tool to top to make visible).

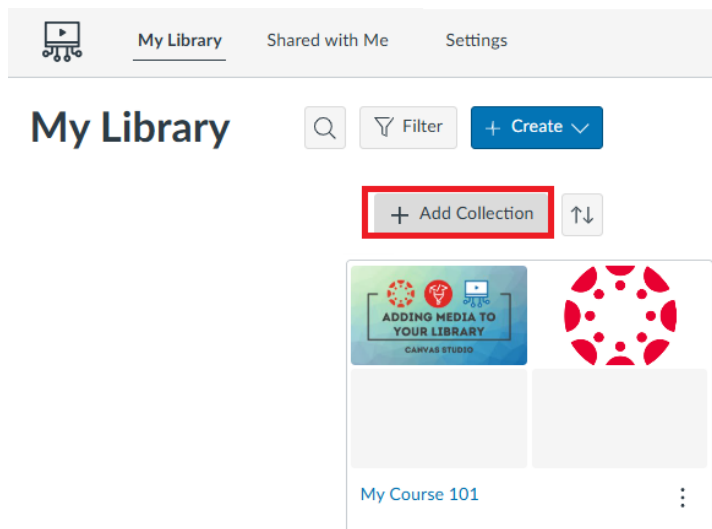
Note: Students do not have access to your Studio Videos if the Studio link is made visible on a course menu.

IMPORTANT: Make sure to add Studio (as external tool link) in course modules. [See below.]



Studio Library: Create collections (i.e. Course Section – My Course 101) to add videos in your Canvas Studio library. Creating a collection allows you to organize your media library and share specific collections and media with other users.

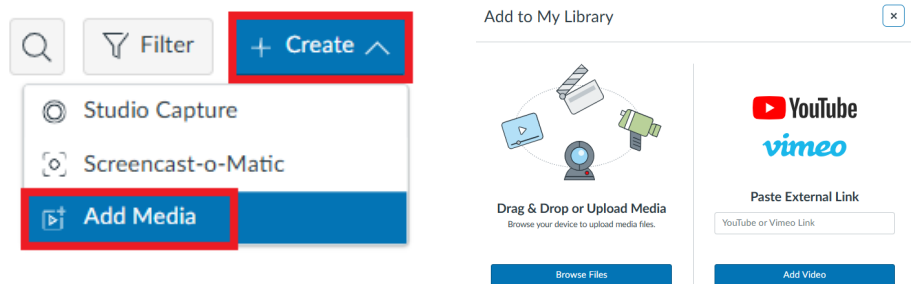
Note: You can move videos to a folder (Collection.)



Upload (Select the “Create” button) videos. You can also create/add videos from YouTube links.

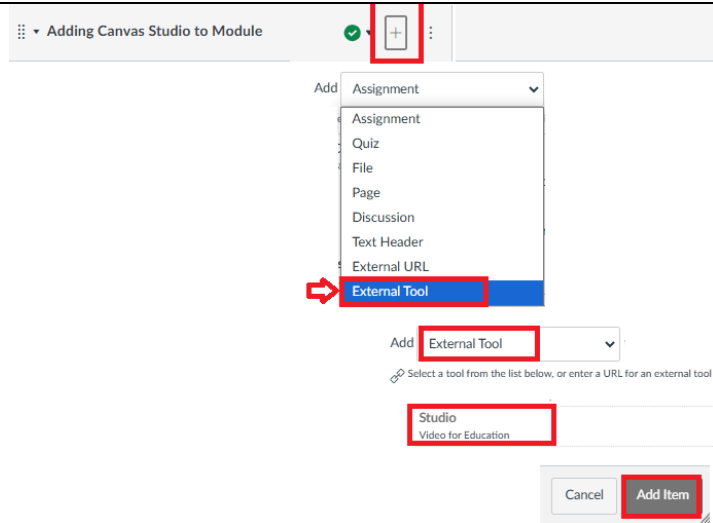
Note: Review the [Studio Guide](#) (PDF) or [online guide](#) (link) on how to create media.

IMPORTANT: Videos will be automatically closed captioned.

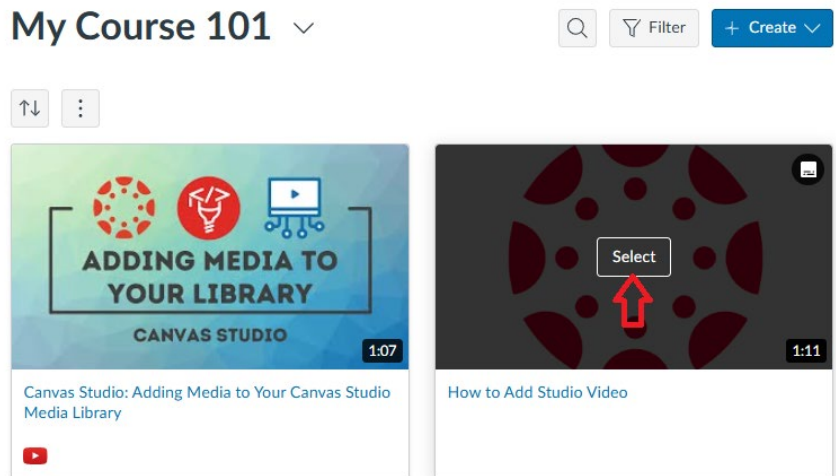
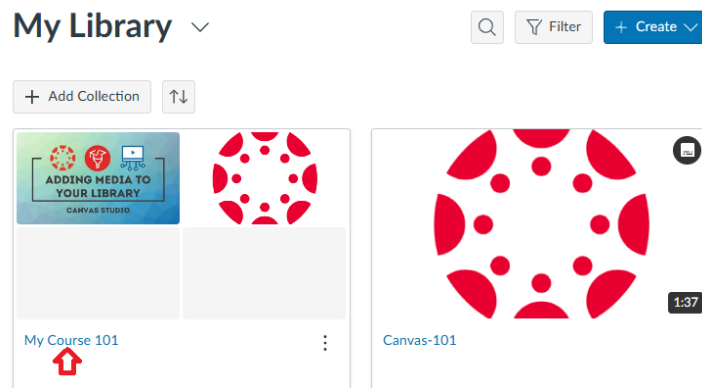


Add Canvas Studio video to Content Module:

1. Go to Module.
2. Click the plus (+) sign.
3. Select to add "External Tool."
4. Scroll down list to find "Studio."
5. Select "Add Item."
6. Double-click on Collection Folder to select video or select from other listed videos not in a collection folder.

7. Select any embed options by toggling to show "green."
8. Select "Embed Media."
9. Select "Add Item."
10. Link will be visible in the Module as unpublished. Make sure to publish.

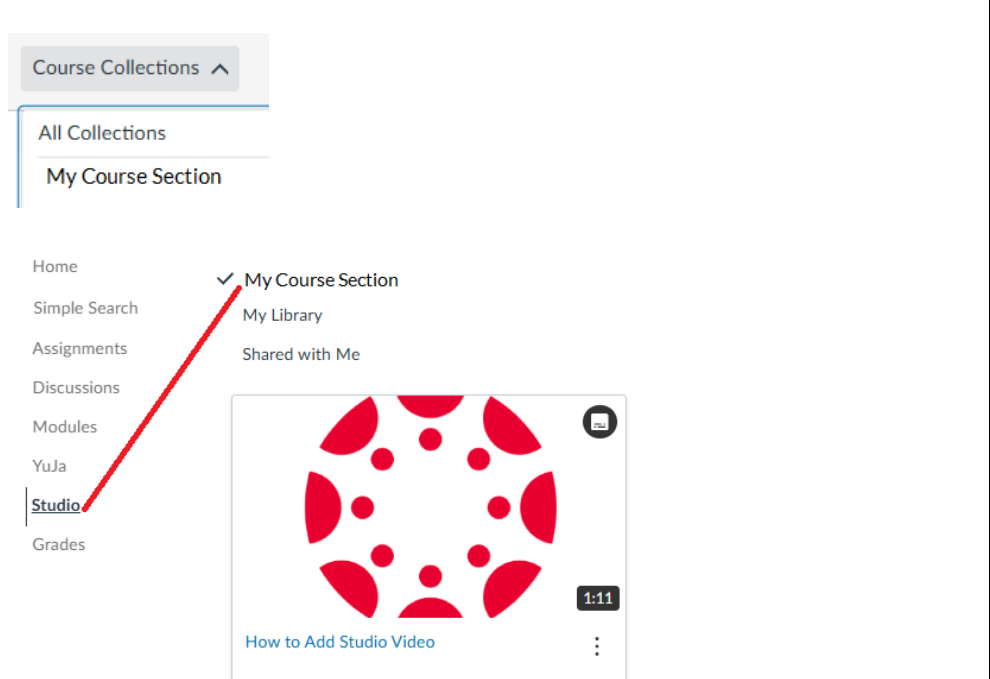
How to Add Studio Video

A copy of the video will be added to the Course Section.

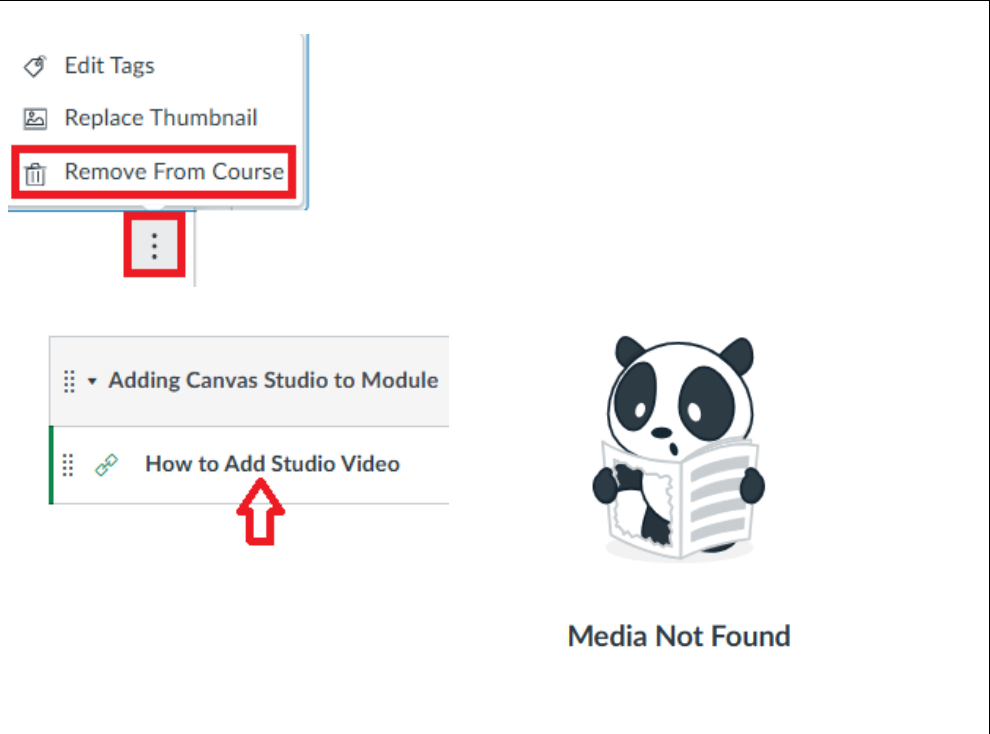
You can access/view course section from the Library under the Global Menu link by selecting the “Course Collections” tab.
